TAPE THAT

We are a collective of six artists and formed TAPE THAT in 2011. Inspired by the idea of creating something artistic out of an everyday object, we work mostly with tapes and foils. Over the last few years, we have explored various approaches and adhesive materials, and come to cherish their limitations as well as the novel possibilities. Our artistic roots can be found in contemporary urban art, graffiti, and design. Ranging from complex and room-filling installations to minimalistic black and white murals, our works can be found everywhere from festivals, nightclubs, and abandoned buildings to art galleries and showrooms. Although based in Berlin, we regularly travel the world to raise awareness of tape art and establish it as an acknowledged form of art. We have also been organizing and curating the Tape Art Convention since 2016, to connect like minded artists and strengthen the existing tape art movement.

OUR PHILOSOPHY

Our fascination for tape art lies in the combination of endless creative possibilities and the natural limitations that one has to deal with while working with tape. We are constantly challenged and inspired by the different characteristics of this medium, and the ways in which it influences our creative process. It is important for us to always incorporate the surrounding environment when creating each piece, thus ensuring an unique expression that fits within its context. Some of our artworks are simplistic and minimal, while others consist of intricate and complex structures. Working as a collective, each of us contributes their own unique styles and ideas, that complement and inspire the group's work as a whole. Each project has a strong focus on cooperation – not only within the collective but also with the organizations we work with, other artists, art enthusiasts, and art novices. Through our work, we have had the opportunity to spread tape art as an art form and to introduce it to people around the globe who were unaware of its existence. This is probably the most rewarding aspect of our work, and we are more than excited to be a part of a movement that is just beginning.

TAPE ART

As the name suggests, Tape Art is art made out of adhesive tape. While this art form has grown rapidly over the last 10 years, its beginnings are not easy to pin down in time: Even though adhesive tapes have long been used in the arts, they were usually not the predominant means of expression, but rather a technical aid. The emancipation to a self-sufficient medium is most likely to be found in and also intertwined with the beginning of the urban art movement. Its removable and temporary nature makes it a thankful medium to use on any surface it sticks to, thus making it easy to integrate in urban environments. As there exists a large variety of different adhesive tapes, the approaches to creating art with them are very diverse. The most commonly used materials are cloth or duct tapes, paper tapes, packaging tapes or plastic tapes and foils. Depending on the specific features of the individual materials, certain styles developed over time that cover a large spectrum from abstract to realistic art.

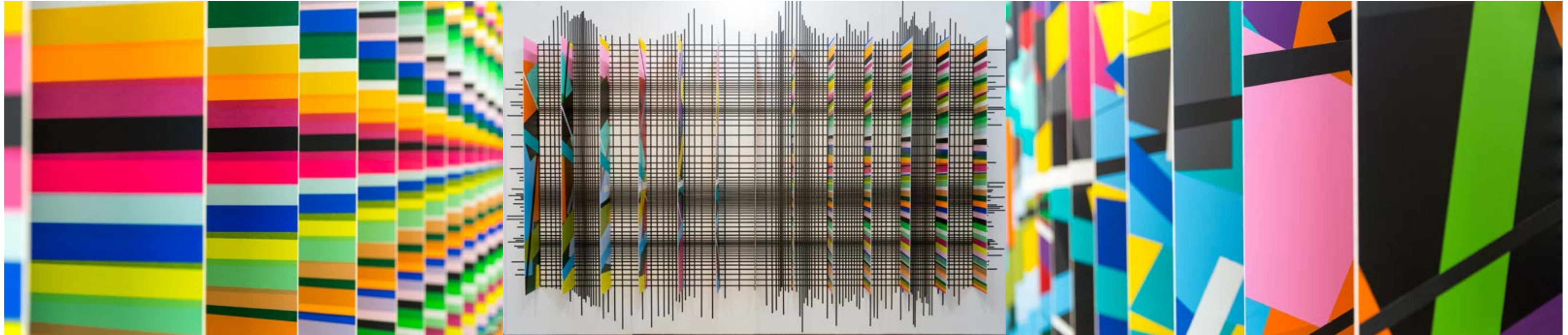

The Tape Art Convention is a recurring group exhibition featuring international artists that predominantly work with tape as a creative medium. Bringing together artists from different backgrounds and cultures, the exhibition features a wide array of different approaches to tape art and showcases the most significant artists of the steadily growing scene. Besides connecting the artists with each other and with art enthusiasts from all over the world, the Tape Art Convention was initiated to further establish tape art as an art form and present it to a broad audience. Starting out with 9 international artists and collectives in 2016, the Tape Art Convention grew to the largest international tape art exhibition with 20 artists and collectives in 2018. In cooperation with Klebeland GmbH, it has grown to a platform and network for tape artists around the world. An important part of the Tape Art Convention are events that focus explicitly on the interaction with visitors, such as creative clashes, workshops and live Tape Art.

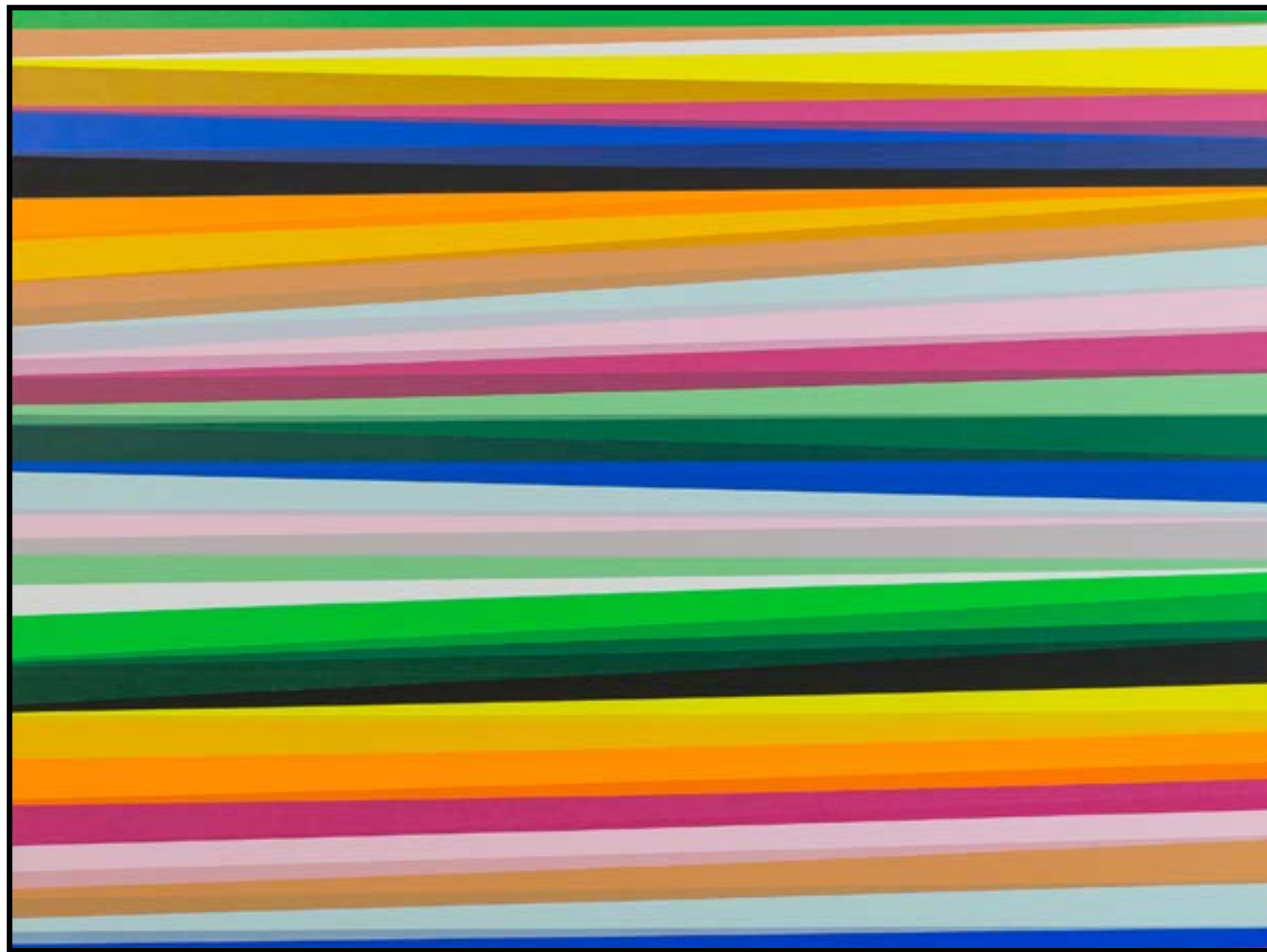

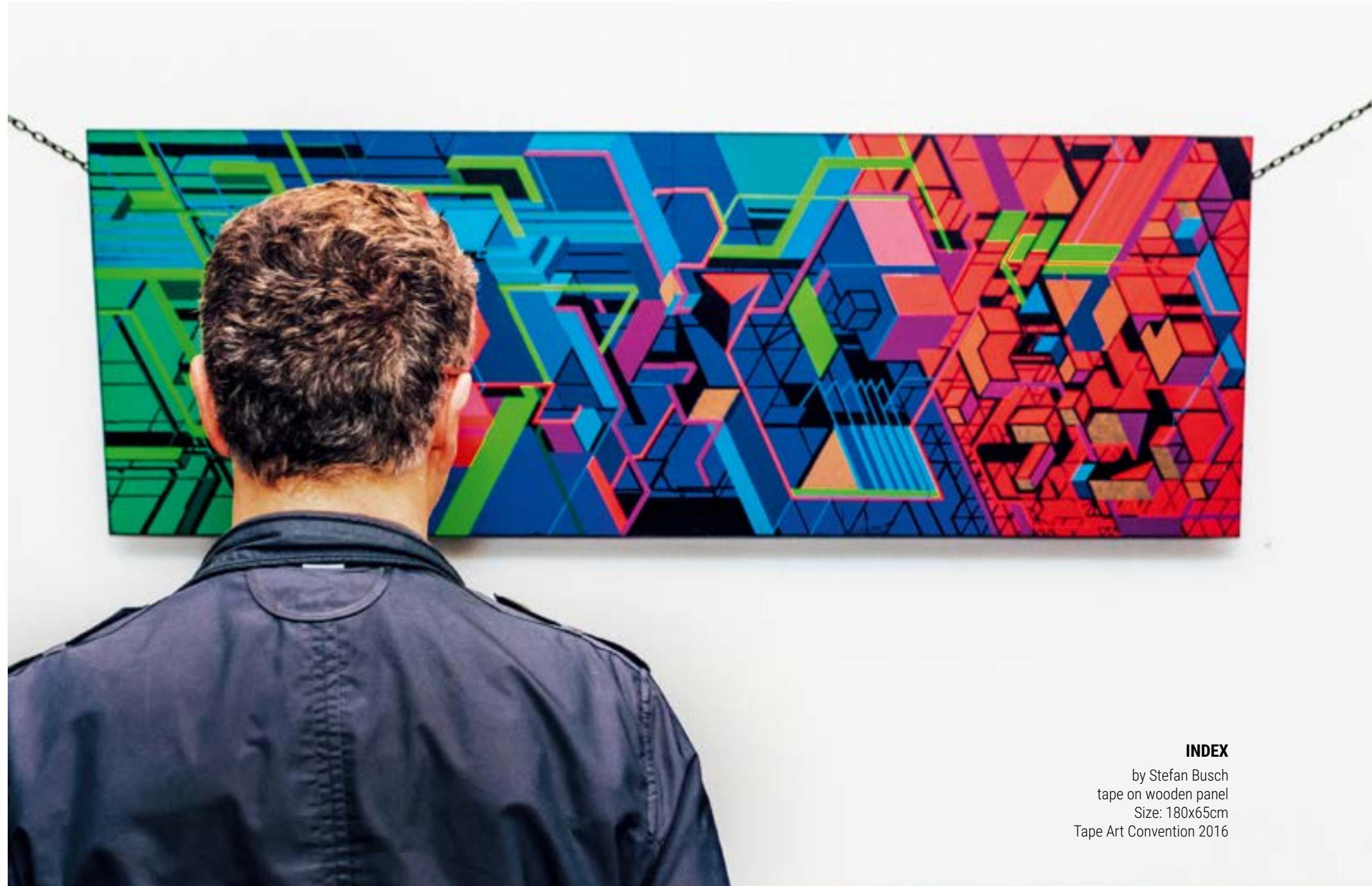

TAPE ART AROUND THE WORLD

**SPREADING THE WORD:
CREATING ART OUT OF
AN EVERYDAY OBJECT**



We consider ourselves to be tape art ambassadors: Tapes can be found in almost every household around the world – and that is all one needs to get creative and start making tape art! No expensive paints or canvases are necessary and one can start instantly. We are fascinated by this open source approach to create art and therefore started “Tape Art around the World”, a project in which we travel around the globe to plant a creative seed and to spread tape art to different places and cultures. Often in cooperation with the German Federal Foreign Office or the Goethe-Institute, we have conducted workshops and taped murals in various countries such as Bangladesh, Belarus, Bulgaria, Bolivia, Cambodia, China, Cuba, Egypt, England, Estonia, Finland, India, Israel, Kosovo, Montenegro, Namibia, Palestine, Peru, Portugal, Qatar, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Sweden, the United States and Vietnam.



KUWAIT

We were honored to be one of only a few selected European artists who were invited to the opening of Shaikh Abdullah Al Salem Cultural Centre in Kuwait City. The centre consists of six different museum buildings, where we taped two murals on the inside facing facades of the museum for space and science as well as the museum of transportation and robotics history. In addition we held an open workshop in the centre of fine arts, in which participants were invited to help us create another mural.

JAPAN

For their 10th anniversary, the Japanese tape manufacturer mt masking tapes invited us to create two large artworks for their open factory tour. The first artwork is a 15x7m mural of a geisha taping her own kimono. In Japan's traditional culture geishas are a symbol for muse and creativity. The second artwork is an anamorphic room installation. The room was open for people to go inside, become part of the artwork, play around, pose and take photos.

ASIA TOUR

We toured through southeast asia in 2016, with stops in Guangzhou (China), Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City (Vietnam). The purpose of the tour was a cultural exchange program, organised by the German embassies in China and Vietnam in cooperation with local art centers such as Redtory Art District and Creative City Hanoi. Besides conducting several workshops, we created murals in public spaces and exhibited the works of our participants together with our artworks. Some of our participants were even able to sell their works which was a particularly happy moment for us. After our workshop in Hanoi, some students were commissioned to create tape art at an art festival and in exchange inspired us with completely new approaches to tape art.

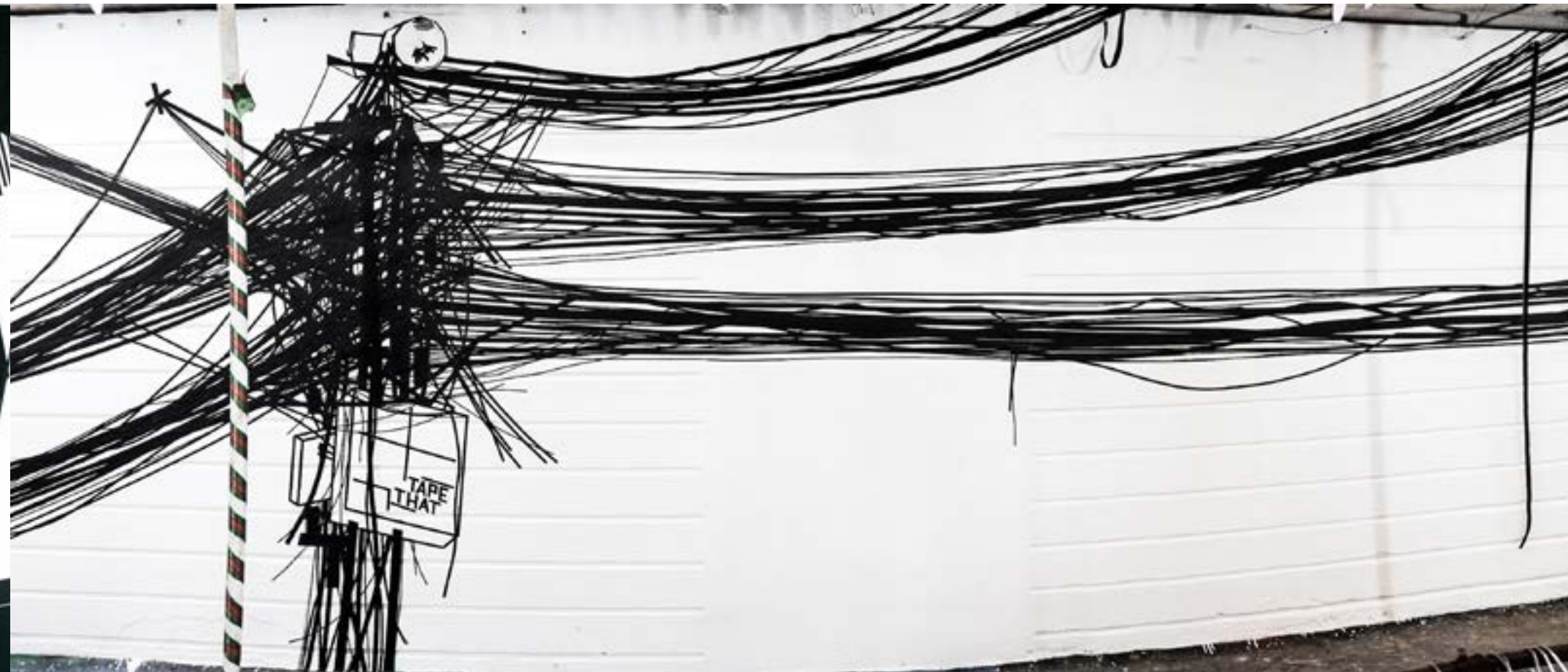

PALESTINE

The Palestinian Museum in Birzeit is the first of its kind built to preserve and document the troubled history of the Palestinian people. With this in mind, we were particularly honored to be invited there. We conducted a workshop and created our artwork "Wall Walk" live. Additionally, we hosted further workshops in Jerusalem and Bethlehem. Finally we went to the West Bank Barrier to leave our marks on it. It surely was one of our most controversial journeys as our memories from it are equally filled with moments of great joy as well as feelings of deep desperation and anger.

SAUDI ARABIA

We were invited to the Misk Art Festival close to Riyadh to participate in a large art exhibition, hosting a multitude of European and local artists. Tape Art was, as in many countries, still completely unknown in Saudi Arabia. For this occasion we prepared a showcase of different styles from abstract artworks to a pop art portrait of the prince of Saudi Arabia. The work "Fingerprint" refers to the refugee crisis as a connecting topic between Germany and Saudi Arabia, a leading regional power in the arabic world. The fingerprint was taken from a kurdish refugee we met in Berlin and was exhibited in conjunction with a story about his life.

Our artistic endeavors range from our free artworks and installations to commissioned projects and intercultural art exchanges as well as workshops. We produce a wide spectrum of free artworks that include regular taped paintings, room installations and sculptures, murals or facades and light installations. Besides live tape art performances at events and fairs, our commissioned projects also consist of location styling and interior design for event locations, fair stands and offices. In addition, we offer tape art workshops and teambuilding activities. To spread tape art around the world, we showcase our artworks internationally and hold workshops for the public, often times in cooperation with the German foreign ministry or Goethe-Institutes.

ARTCADEN

Camouflage: becoming one with Tape Art. In the fall of 2017 we were invited by the Berlin based artist collective „Die Dixons“ to do whatever we could imagine in an empty 300 square meter space, inside the Wilmersdorfer Arcaden mall in Berlin. Several different artist groups, including visual artists, a dance crew and virtual reality designers were involved in the project, transforming empty shops of the mall into an artistic playground. We decided to paint the whole place white and tape 4 large installations in different areas of the room. We added furniture, such that each area became a room of itself. The furniture was partly white and partly the same design as the area. To make the installation interactive we created clothing in the same style as the respective artwork. Thus, visitors were not only observers of the artwork but could become one with it. Some visitors even took it one step further and created their own art on top of ours and used the installation for dancing, photography and videography.

We had the opportunity to participate in the famous Festival of Lights in Berlin in 2018. During the festival various public spots are illuminated with and transformed by images and videos by artists from all over the world. We created a collage of various recent artworks. The collage was showcased on the „Fernsehturm“ (TV Tower) in the heart of Berlin. Further we taped a 100m hallway of the atrium tower and thus created a walkable artwork. For this project we created an interlacing structure of straight lines that brought color into an otherwise monochrome surrounding.

OHHH DE COLOGNE

This 5m tall art piece we've created as a perfect match for the newly opened concept store "Ohhh De Cologne". We installed it in the beginning of 2018 in the Cologne Passage. It shows a process of how a face arises out of a simple pattern of straight lines. The lines seemingly flow from the top and form the hair of this lady. We hope visitors don't feel intimidated by her slightly posh and severe appearance. The piece was created out of foil and finalized with tapes on a large PVC foam board construction.

We had free choice of their entire tape collection for this artwork, so we tried some transparent colorized packaging tape. By layering it we achieved an aesthetic similar to infrared camera images. The sunglasses are taped with reflecting aluminum tape.



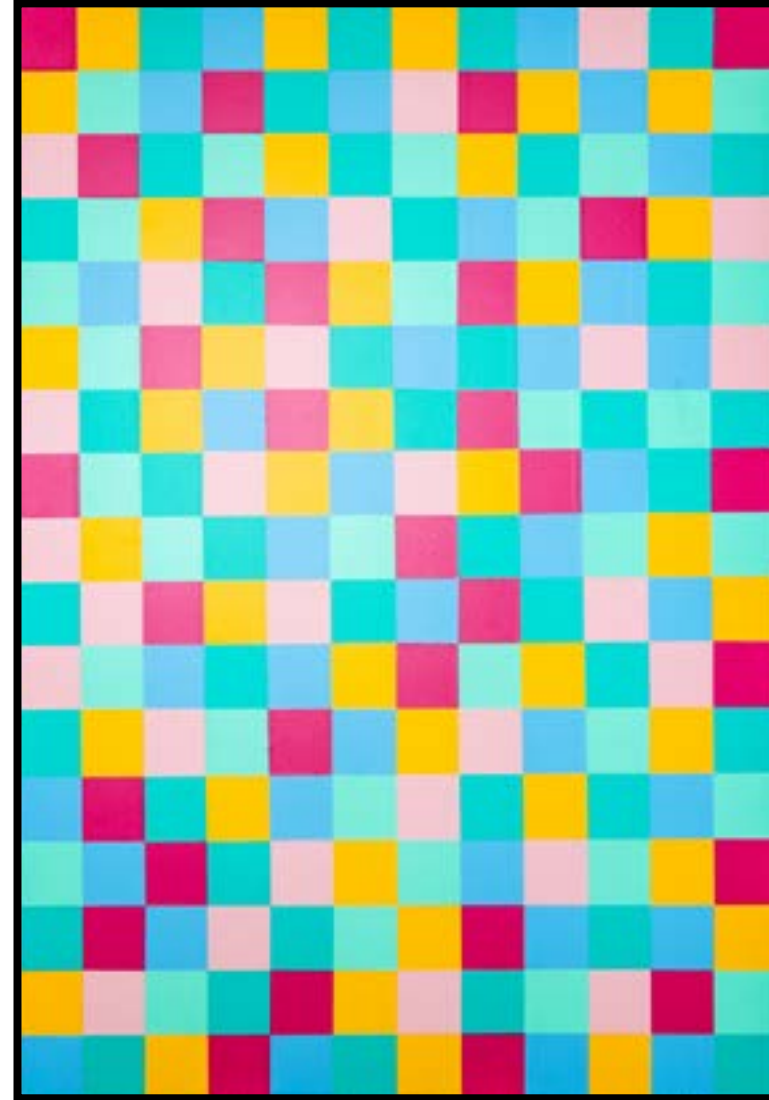
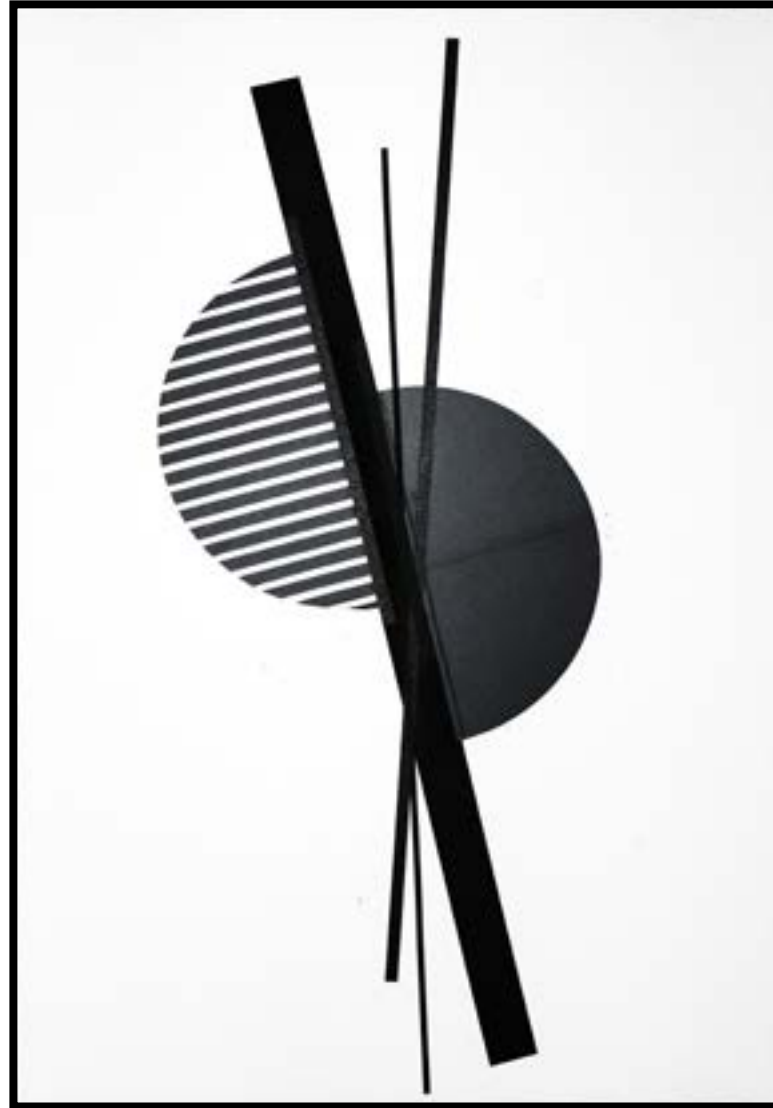

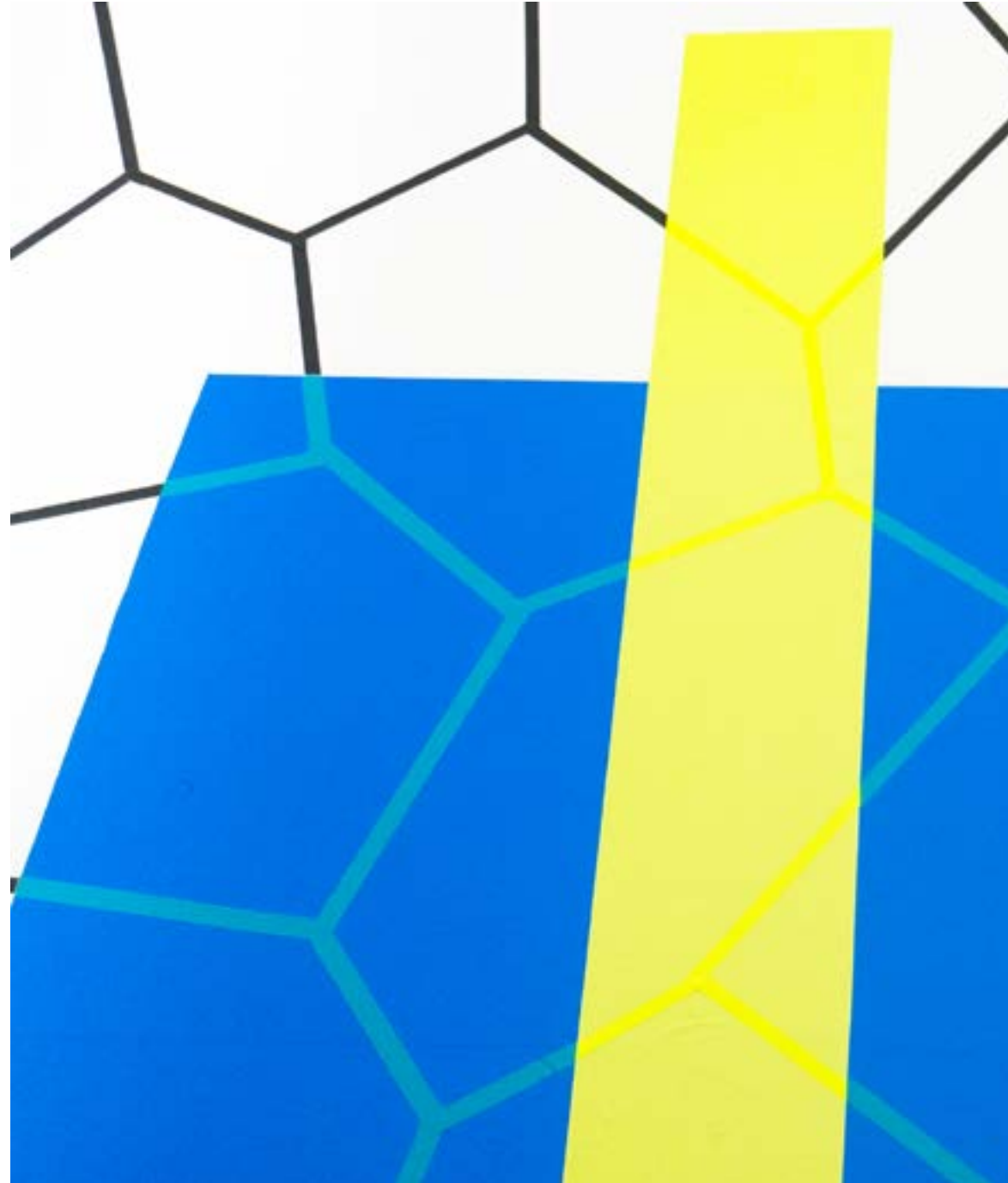
